## **Single Vehicle Collision Claims Life of Motorcycle Rider**

(April 24, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a north Phoenix single vehicle collision involving a motorcycle that resulted in one man's death.

On April 24, 2024, around 5:30 p.m., officers responded to the area of 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue and Union Hills Drive regarding a single vehicle collision where a motorcycle rider was thrown from his bike. When officers arrived, they located the adult male motorcycle rider, identified as 33-year-old Nathan Crumpler, with serious injuries. Crumpler was transported to a nearby hospital however he did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that Crumpler was northbound on 25<sup>th</sup> Avenue when he lost control of his motorcycle and struck a raised curb. The collision resulted in Crumpler being thrown from the motorcycle. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
