Single Vehicle Collision Leaves One Dead

(March 18, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a single vehicle collision that resulted in a man's death.

On March 18, 2024, around 8:00 a.m., officers responded to the area of the 29th Avenue and Southern Avenue regarding a single vehicle collision where the vehicle struck a pole. When officers arrived, they located an adult male, identified as 51-year-old Thomas Wilcox, with serious injuries. Wilcox was transported to a nearby hospital, but he did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that Wilcox's vehicle was westbound on Southern Avenue when for unknown reasons it exited the roadway and collided with a pole. Additional details about this incident remain part of the ongoing investigation.
