Monday Morning Collision Leaves Motorcyclist Dead

(October 14, 2024) Phoenix Police Vehicular Crimes detectives investigate a deadly collision that left one man dead.

On October 14, 2024, around 6:00 a.m., officers responded to a collision involving a motorcyclist in the area of 4200 East Indian School Road. Officers located an adult male suffering from critical injuries. The man was pronounced deceased on scene by the fire department.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the motorcyclist identified as 29-year-old Kyler Devlin was eastbound on Indian School Road when he collided with Unit 2, a Toyota pickup truck. The truck was attempting to make a left turn out of a private drive to go west on Indian School Road. Kyler suffered fatal injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene. Kyler was wearing a helmet, but it is believed to have come off in the collision.

Unit 2, the Toyota truck operated by a 44-year-old male, was on the south side of Indian School Road. The truck was attempting to make a left turn from a private drive to go westbound on Indian School Road when he was struck on the driver side front quarter panel by Unit 1, Kyler who was traveling in the curb lane. The pickup truck driver remained on scene and cooperated with the investigation. The driver showed no signs of impairment.

Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
