## **Family Fight Call Ends in Multiple Collisions and Man's Death**

(May 17, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating multiple incidents that included a collision that left a bicyclist dead.

On May 16, 2024, around 8:00 p.m., officers responded to a home near 6200 South 16<sup>th</sup> Street regarding a domestic violence call. When officers arrived, they encountered an adult male identified as 33-year-old Jamarr Young who was immediately aggressive towards officers. Young refused to obey commands given by the officers and got into his vehicle which was parked in the front of the home. Young quickly drove his car towards multiple officers and hit a fully marked police Tahoe in order to make an avenue of escape. Young drove away northbound on 16<sup>th</sup> Street from the home and away from officers.

As Young was traveling northbound on 16<sup>th</sup> Street, he struck an adult male who was crossing 16<sup>th</sup> Street on a bicycle. Young did not stop after the collision and continued northbound on 16<sup>th</sup> Street. Officers arrived at the collision location and attempted lifesaving measures on the bicyclist, but he did not survive his injuries. He was pronounced deceased on scene.

Officers were able to relocate Young's vehicle and attempted to stop it. Young refused to pull over and a pursuit was initiated by the officers. Officers continued this pursuit until Young's driving became so erratic that the pursuit was called off. Young continued to flee until he collided with perimeter fencing at a construction area in Tempe, near the Interstate 10 and US 60 interchange. Young attempted to run away on foot but was caught by officers. Young assaulted officers before he was placed into handcuffs.

Young was transported to a nearby hospital for treatment of minor injuries suffered during the collection of incidents. Once he was released from medical care, he was booked into jail on 11 total

charges to include murder, leaving the scene of an accident with injuries, aggravated DUI and multiple counts of aggravated assault on a police officer. He was also charged with assault in relation to the original domestic violence incident that generated the first call for service.

Additional details about this incident in total remain part of the ongoing investigation.
