

16th Street from Baseline Road to Western Canal

Project Summary

- Proposed roadway reconfiguration to add bike lanes and adjust the width of the travel lanes between the Western Canal and Baseline Road.
- The current width of the travel lanes closer to the curb exceeds the recommended standard.
- A HAWK is being designed at Western Canal.
- Planned (Mill & Overlay) pavement project.
- No public meeting required
- Cross-section: D, 2-1-2.

Where: 16th Street from Baseline Road to Western Canal

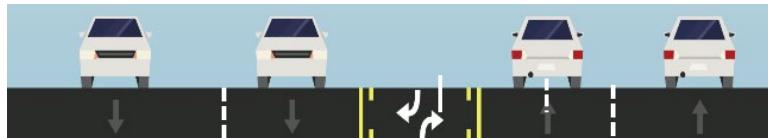
What: There is an opportunity to add bike lanes by adjusting the width of the travel lanes along the corridor from the Western Canal to Baseline Rd.

When: Pavement maintenance (Mill & Overlay) is planned for FY 2027 and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

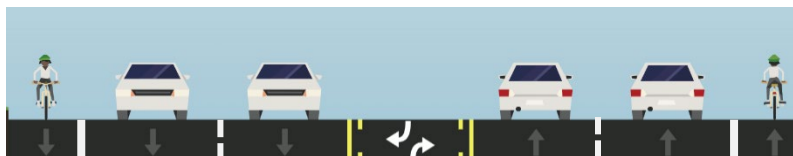
Why: Bike lanes add space between people driving and people walking or biking for increased protection from vehicles, improved safety and added comfort. Additionally, adjusting the width lanes to a safe standard might help reduce speeding.
