

9th Street from Gary Lane (Canal) to Baseline Road

Project Summary

- Street is wide enough to add bike lanes.
- Residential street that leads to the Highline Canal that allows parking at all times.
- Requires parking removal.
- Planned pavement project.

Where: 9th Street from Gary Lane (Canal) to Baseline Road

What: Where there is enough space on the roadway, bike lanes will be added. The number of travel lanes will remain the same. Parking will be removed from ten side facing houses and one church.

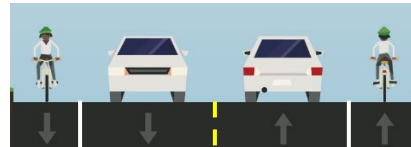
When: Pavement maintenance (new asphalt) is planned for Summer 2026, and traffic lane improvements will happen shortly after.

Why: Bike lanes will add space between people driving and people walking or biking for increased protection from vehicles, improved safety and added comfort. Additionally, the slight narrowing of the lane widths to accommodate the bike lanes will help to guide cars and deter speeding.

(Parking allowed at all times, both sides)

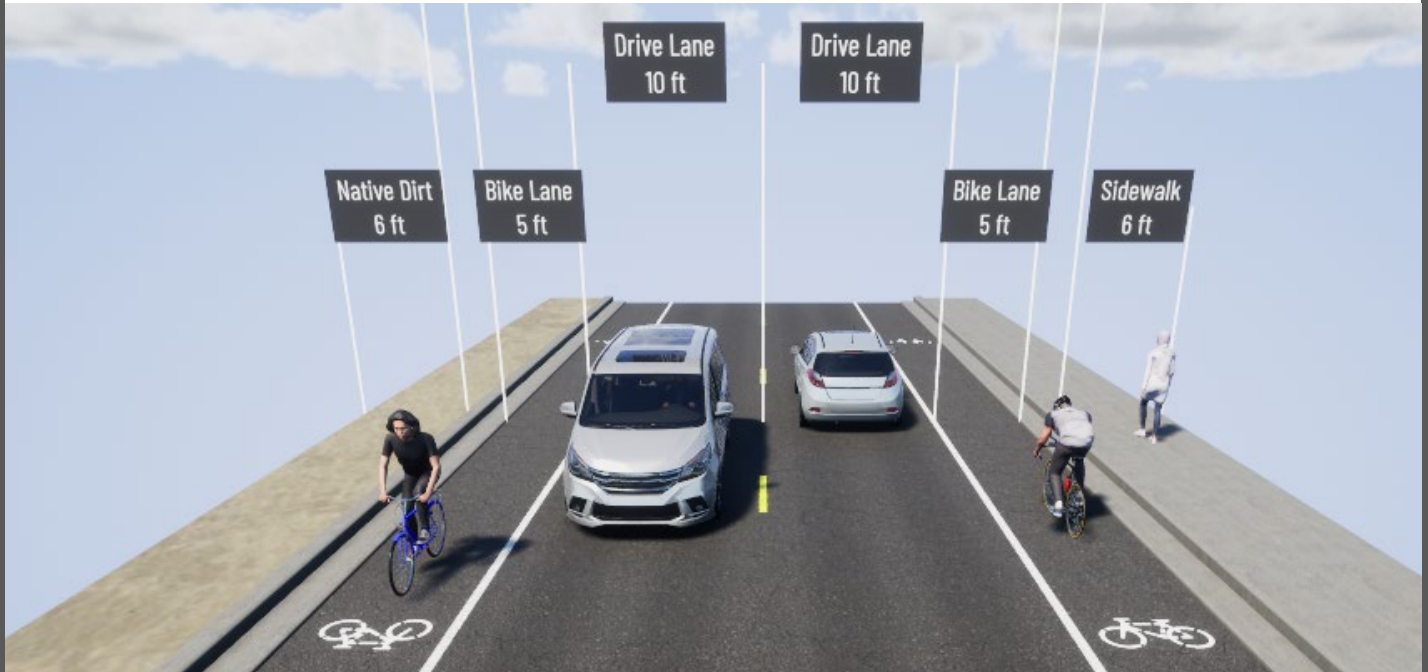


Proposed Travel Lanes
