- Earn **2 Continuing Education Units (CEUs)** per session—flexible and hassle-free! Join us whenever it fits your schedule!

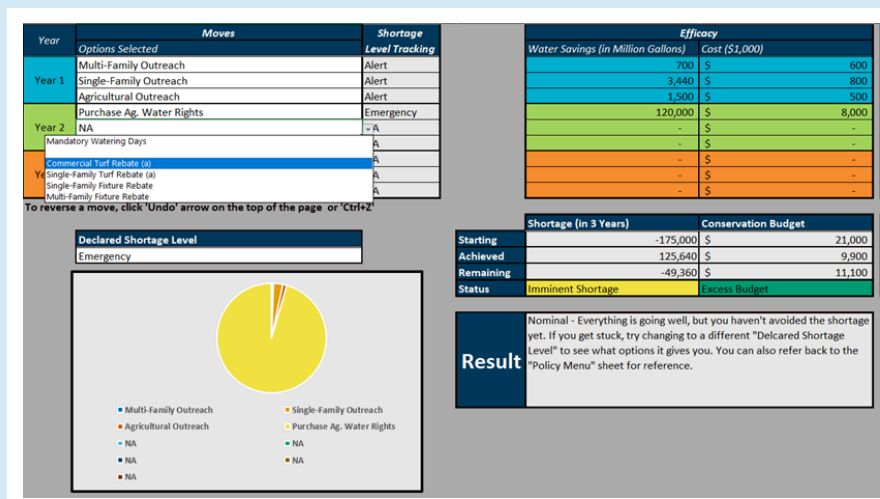
