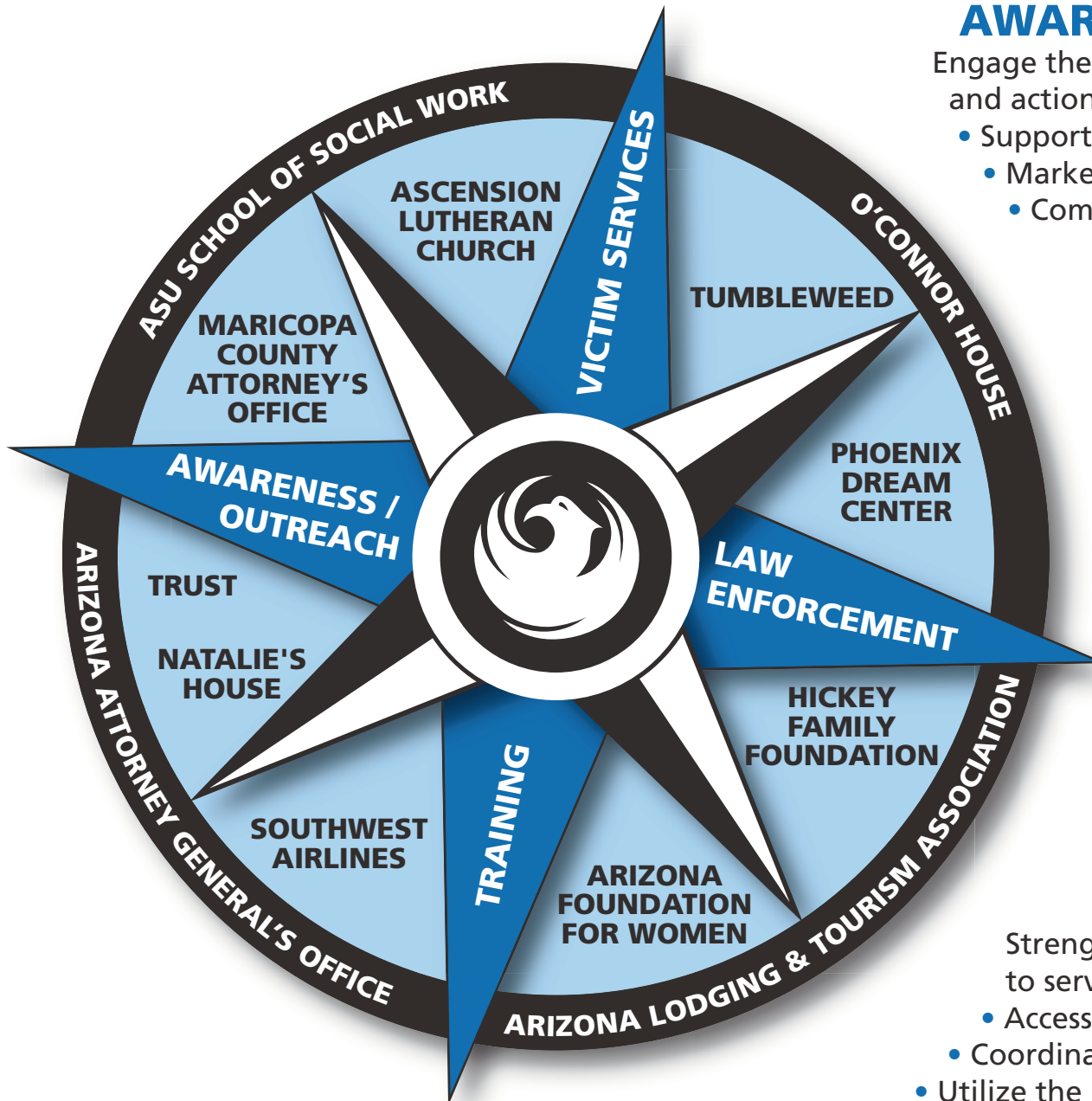


# CITY OF PHOENIX COMPASS PLAN

To establish the City of Phoenix as a model in preventing and combating Human Trafficking.

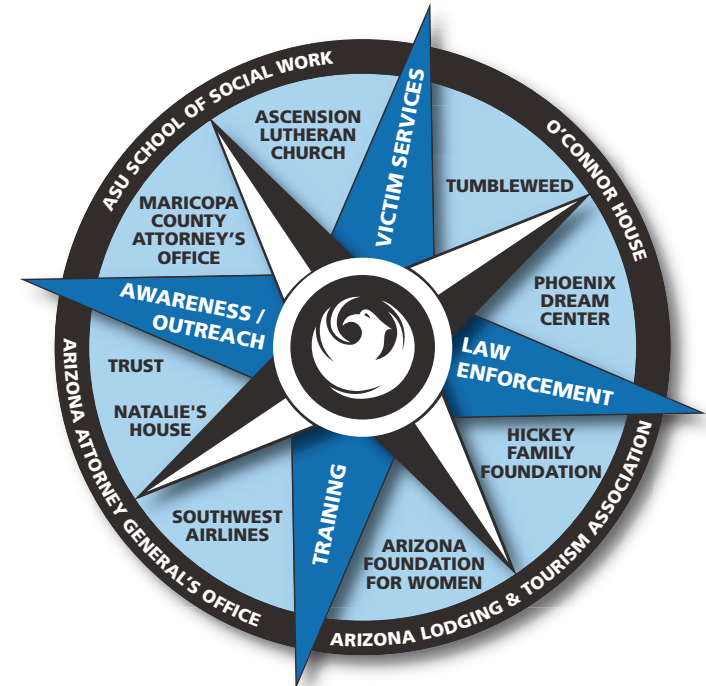
## Phoenix COMPASS plan:
