Holiday Trash/Recycling Collection Schedule

As Christmas approaches, please be aware of the upcoming <u>holiday collection</u> <u>schedules</u>. All residents will have an altered schedule during the weeks of Christmas and New Year's.

• Solid waste collections will not be provided on Christmas Day (Monday, December 25, 2023). All solid waste collections will be pushed back by one day that week, starting with Monday's collections being provided on Tuesday, and ending with Friday's collections being provided on Saturday.

• Solid waste collections will not be provided on New Year's Day (Monday, January 1, 2024). All solid waste collections will be pushed back by one day that week, starting with Monday's collections being provided on Tuesday, and ending with Friday's collections being provided on Saturday.


Office of Homeless Solutions

The Office of Homeless Solutions (OHS) provides support for people experiencing homelessness and is committed to ending homelessness through a comprehensive, regional approach to shelter and heat relief, outreach, supportive and behavioral health services, homelessness prevention, and supportive housing.

This monthly report does not encompass the totality of the City's efforts to address homelessness but rather provides a review of the key highlights from the preceding month and an update on major upcoming projects.

District 3 Street Transportation Department Updates

This report from the Street Transportation Department covers the period from October 27 through November 30 in District 3.

Traffic Signals

Street Transportation is installing new traffic signals at 25th Ave. and Mountain View Rd.; 25th Ave. and Mission Ln.; and 25th Ave. and Arizona Canal (9300 N.) in D3 as part of the Light Rail Northwest Extension.

Pedestrian Signal Updates

Street Transportation installed a new High Intensity Activated CrossWalk (HAWK) pedestrian signal at 17th Ave. and Peoria Ave. in D3.

ADA Curb Ramp Retrofit

These projects include the removal and replacement of non-ADA (Americans with Disabilities Act) compliant curb ramps, damaged concrete curb, gutter, valley gutters, and aprons or sidewalks, and the installation of new ADA compliant curb ramps. Newly compliant ADA ramps were installed in the areas bounded by 19th Ave to 7th Ave., Sweetwater Ave. to Thunderbird Rd.

Street Right-of-Way Landscape Maintenance

Crews maintained the street right-of-way on 32nd St. and Greenway Rd.; Greenway Pkwy. from 7th St. to 12th St.; 19th Ave. and Peoria, 19th Ave. and Bell Rd. 19th Ave. and SR101. This work typically includes weed and trash removal and landscape pruning. This helps provide a safe environment for the public and enhances the image of the city's streets. Drainage Maintenance

As part of routine maintenance, crews inspect for obstructions, clear vegetation,

and make repairs to keep flow lines open. Crews performed maintenance, construction, and repair work at Bell Rd. from I-17 to 7th Ave.

Intersection Improvements

Street Transportation is improving the following intersections to include full traffic signal upgrades and raised median modifications to improve the negative offsets at left-turn lanes: 7th Ave and Bell Rd.; 16th St and Greenway Pkwy.; and 29th St. Greenway Rd.

31st Street, Thunderbird to Hearn Roads Improvement Project

This project is designed to improve pedestrian safety and accessibility by installing new concrete curb, gutter, sidewalk, and pavement. This project will also improve drainage conditions by installing new storm drain inlets/catch basins and storm drain infrastructure at 31st St. from Thunderbird Rd. to Hearn Rd. A new waterline and streetlights will also be included. The project is anticipated to be completed in December 2023. <u>Visit phoenix.gov/streets/31stTBirdtoHearn</u> for more information.
