

Phoenix City Council Considering Parking Meters at Mountain Parks

<u>I strongly oppose, as I did two years ago, any measure to install parking</u> <u>meters in our parks</u>. It is my belief that we should encourage, rather than impede use of our parks.

A proposed measure to install parking meters at Phoenix Mountain Parks including Echo Canyon, Piestewa Peak, Papago Park, and South Mountain will come before the Phoenix City Council in the coming weeks.

If this measure passes, it could cost an avid park user \$1,500 per year in parking fees to enjoy a park that your taxes already fund.
