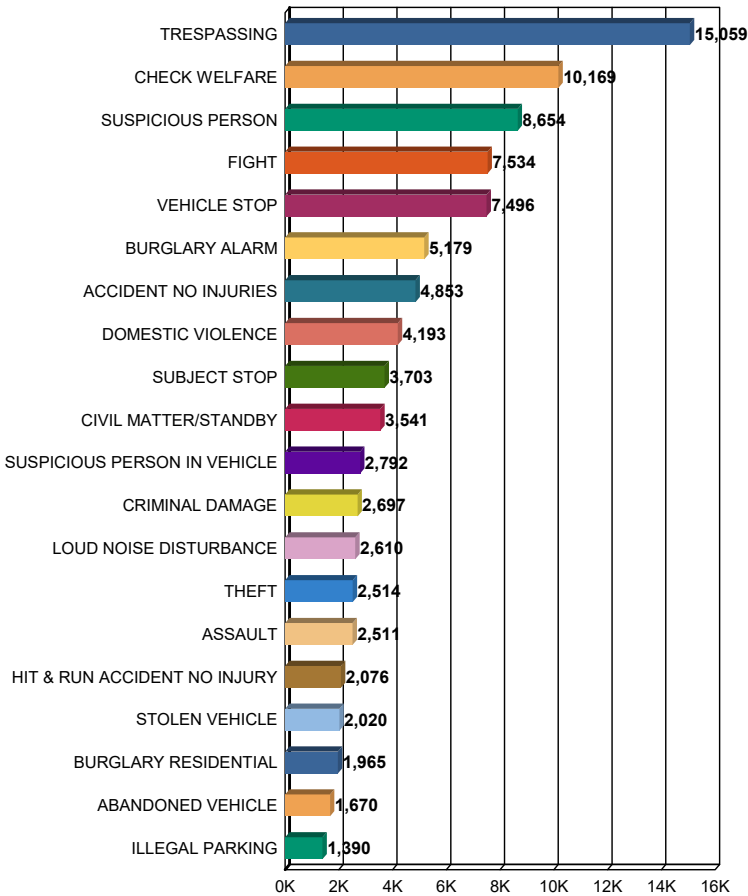
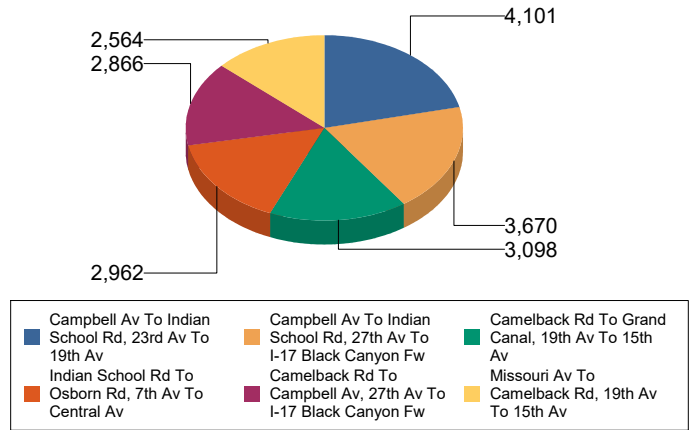




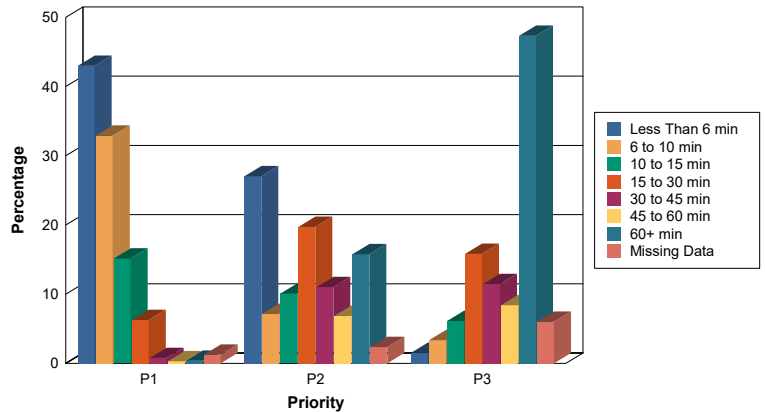
**Count of Dispatched/ Callback/ Self-Initiated (OV) Calls For Top Final Call Types in Council District 4**



**Count of Dispatched/ Callback/ Self-Initiated (OV) Calls For Top Grid Areas in Council District 4**

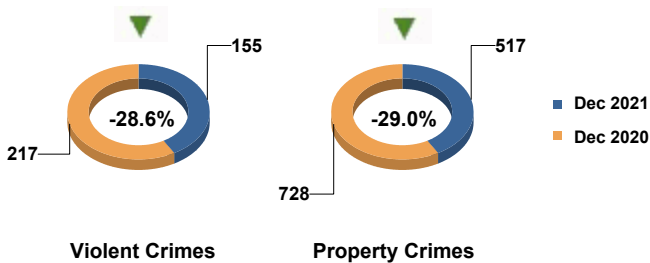


**Dispatched Response Times by Priority in Council District 4**

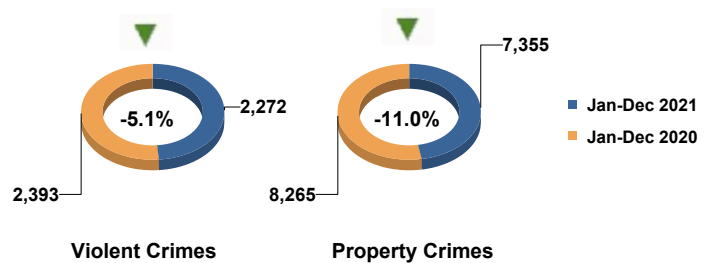

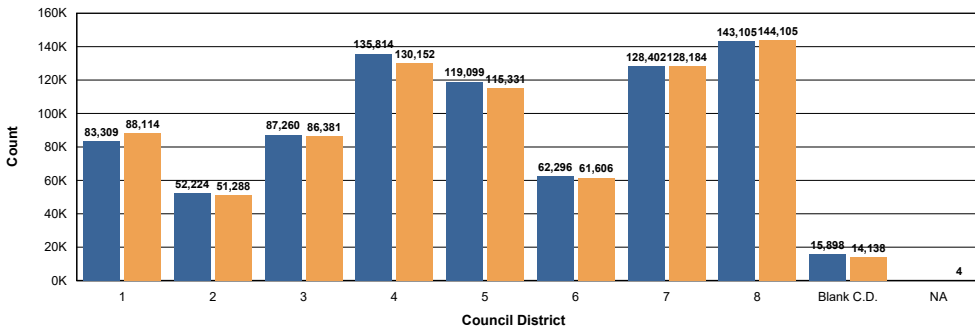

All dispatched/callback/self-initiated calls are included regardless of the final disposition of the call (i.e. report written, no action required, etc.). Non dispatched calls are not included. Each top list may have other data tied for the lowest count displayed that is not shown. Grid boundaries changed effective October 20, 2014. The information in this report is based on georeferenced addresses and may change as the geobase is improved and/or updated. Any inaccuracies in the geobase may result in addresses georeferencing to the incorrect grid, beat, squad, precinct or council district. This report is also based on Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) criteria which are not equivalent to Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS) statistics; therefore, this data cannot be directly compared to ARS reports. Under the hierarchy rule of UCR, only the most severe offense of an incident is counted. Part One property crimes include motor vehicle theft, burglary, arson, and theft/larceny. Part One Violent Crimes include criminal homicide, rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. Homicides, rapes, and aggravated assaults are counted per victim. Numbers may differ from other published reports due to case updates/reclassifications and/or to differences associated with unfounded incidents. N/C = not calculable.
