### Little Free Libraries

Little Free Library (LFL) is a “library” box in the shape of houses, barber shops, schools, etc. full of books where anyone can pick up a book (or two) and bring back another book to share. The overall goal is to create a place for families to gather and share their literature and stories. LFL will be placed in communities of need to inspire the love of reading. Locations may include:

- A local business like barber shops, coffee shops, etc.
- Any area that may not be served by a public library.
- A city park or community garden.
- Along a bike trail or jogging path.
- A dog park.
