# 2020 Census: Phoenix Mission and Vision

- Raise dedicated funds to support outreach goals.

### Challenges and Opportunities



- Census redesigned:
  - Internet/Electronic Responses (Digital Divide)
    - 2015 West Phoenix Census Test
  - Phone
  - Paper Form
- Reduce Costs
  - Streamlined office and staffing structure
- Educate/Motivate to increase response rate





### Citizenship Question Lawsuit



#### April 3, 2018

• New York Attorney General filed lawsuit challenging inclusion of the citizenship question.

#### May 22, 2018

• Phoenix City Council voted to join the lawsuit.

#### November 2018

• Case ended with closing arguments.

#### January 15, 2019

• Judge rules ordering the removal of the citizenship question.

#### Next Steps:

• Appeals process with the possibility of the US Supreme Court hearing the case.
