DO I QUALIFY FOR SECTION 8?

The Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program is the largest federal housing program. The city's Housing Choice Voucher Program provides housing for more than 5,400 households. Single persons and families of low income who are below the maximum income limit may qualify.

The Housing Department performs criminal background checks for all adult household members. In most cases a criminal history does not mean applications will automatically be rejected. The Housing Department will review each applicant’s criminal history individually, except in limited circumstances.

The Housing Department screens all adult household members for, including but not limited to, debts owed to former landlords, evictions from former landlords and previous government subsidized units.
