## Can I go to the clinic during work hours?

Banner Aetna HMO members– No cost for the visit BCBS PPO members– No cost for the visit Savers Choice Plan member will pay a \$20 copay until your deductible is met. Be sure to show your Plan ID card and Government Issued ID. There is no cost for preventive care.

If you need to get a prescription filled, there are 2 in-network pharmacies (Fry's Grocery Store and CVS) adjacent to the clinic where you can fill your prescriptions.
