is now providing COVID-19 EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE RELIEF

City of Phoenix residents are eligible to apply for rent or mortgage, water, gas and utility bill assistance.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- Households must be City of Phoenix residents
- Financially impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- One-time assistance payment for rent or mortgage and utility obligations incurred after March 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020
- Provide proof of lawful presence

CAN PAY:

- Utility bills (electric/gas)
- City Services Bill (water)
- Rent or Mortgage

PAYMENT AMOUNTS:

- \$600 Utility bills
- \$300 City of Phoenix Water bill
- \$3,300 Rent or Mortgage (Households in subsidized housing must have a rental obligation to qualify for rental assistance.)
- The full payment amount listed above will be issued on behalf of each eligible household assisted, as applicable.
