## The Process Obtaining A Protective Order

## **CHECKLIST:**

O Visit http://azpoint.azcourts.gov to create an account and complete the petition online.



- Once your petition is complete, write down or take a picture of your reference number. Your petition is now with the Court.
- O Go to the <u>Protective Orders Office</u> at the Phoenix Municipal Court at 300 W. Washington St. and provide the clerk with your reference number.
- O You will meet with a judge to discuss your request.
- O If your Order of Protection (domestic violence) is granted the Police Department will attempt to serve it. If your Injunction Against Harassment (non-domestic violence) is granted you will need to coordinate service of the injunction by the Police Department or a private process server.

Please note: Online petitions can be completed on computers, cell phones, and tablets. Computers are available at <a href="Phoenix Municipal Court Protective Orders Office">Phoenix Municipal Court Protective Orders Office</a> to complete the process.
