



DID YOU KNOW?

- Lead can be found in the paint and dust in older homes and apartments.
- Children under six years of age with high levels of lead in their bodies may suffer from damage to the brain, learning problems, hearing loss, and delayed growth.
- Although lead-based paint is no longer used, if you live in a home built before 1978, you may have old peeling or chipping lead-based paint.

Homeowners, Tenants, Landlords

You may be eligible for a no cost program that helps protect children from lead poisoning. Services available include testing your home or apartment for lead, testing your children under six years old for an elevated blood lead level, and repainting or replacing lead surfaces.
