NEIGHBORHOOD SYNERGY CONFERENCE

Once again, NSD will be hosting a one-day neighborhood conference that will feature breakout sessions, an awards luncheon and networking opportunities, all designed to re-invigorate neighborhood advocates and leaders to collaborate, engage and work with others to find solutions to the challenges many neighborhoods face.

We are calling it the **Neighborhood Synergy Conference** and its objective is to empower participants with information and expand their network of resources that could support their neighborhoods' unique initiatives. With a more organized, thoughtful and worthwhile event, NSD hopes to deliver a benefit to being an engaged leader and demonstrate its commitment to remain a staunch partner in improving the quality of life in Phoenix neighborhoods.

AUDIENCE

NSD has invites all of its neighborhood leaders representing various citywide associations, alliances, and some nonprofits registered with Neighborhood Link, the city's official listing of neighborhood groups. These are the volunteer leaders who often engage with residents, business owners and city departments to strategize and find solutions to their neighborhood's challenges. NSD anticipates 300 engaged active, volunteer neighborhood leaders will attend.

AGENDA

The conference will offer up to 16 breakout sessions, discussing topics that include: crime prevention through environmental design; understanding homelessness; how to run a productive neighborhood meeting; finding grants and writing a winning proposal; short-term rentals, and many more. Each session will feature subject matter experts to share practical but valuable information to participants.
