Designated drivers may pick up a parking pass at the Bag Pick-Up & Expo to access the parking lots on the day of the event.

# Take a Po it HIKE RIGHT.

More than **200** hikers annually are rescued from City of Phoenix desert and mountain parks and preserves. This simple checklist can help keep you from becoming a statistic.



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#### Watch the Weather:

Yes, "ii's a dry heat" – but Arizona's temperature can be deceiving and deadly. Hike when it's cool outside, try early mornings and evenings when there's more shade.



#### Dress Appropriately:

Wear proper shoes, clothing, hat and sunscreen.

#### Bring Water:

Hydrate before you go. Have plenty of water, more than you think you need. Turn around and head back to the trailhead before you drink half of your water.



#### Keep in Contact:

Carry a mobile phone.

#### Team Up:

Hike with others. If hiking solo, tell someone your start and end times, and location.

#### Be Honest:

Do you have a medical condition? Asthma, heart problems, diabetes, knee or back problems? Don't push yourself! (Even trained athletes have been caught off guard by getting dehydrated on Arizona trails.)

#### Don't Trailblaze:

Enjoy the Sonoran Desert's beautiful and undeveloped landscape, but please stay on designated trails.

#### Take Responsibility:

Don't be "that person" – the one who wasn't prepared, shouldn't have been there for health reasons or ignored safety guidelines. Be the responsible hiker, who takes a hike and does it right!



After a short segment on the road, return to Holbert trail. Stay on Holbert trail until the junction with the Dobbins extension. Hike up the extension to Dobbins Lookout and your final summit! Out and back hike.

Hike west then southwest up Trail 306, the Shaw Butte Summit trail. The summit is located at the junction of Trail 306 and the private service road to top (where the towers are located). Out and back hike.

Trails will remain open to the public during the event, however, the public is encouraged to use alternate trails. Desert Vista & Piestewa Peak trailheads will be closed on the day of the event to allow Park Rangers to safety in areas with limited parking.

# **RESTROOMS & WATER**

PSC trails will have permanent or portable restrooms and drinking water available on the day of the event.

# LEAVE PETS AT HOME
