PRIOR to Log-In OR Upload of Self-Certified Building Plans

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Civil Engineering Approvals

Construction plans approved, and bonds posted:

- Grading and Drainage (permit must be obtained)
- Storm Water Management (permit must be obtained)
- Offsite Water and/or Sewer
- Concrete
- Paving
- Plot Plans (G&D review for residential custom homes)




Civil Plans

- 1. The importance of this slide is to focus on off-site improvements.
- 2. Driveway permits because they can be purchased over the counter.
 - a. Purchase a permit and add it's number to the plans or note it is under separate permit.
- 3. Concrete work in rights-of-way is permitted on the grading and drainage plan for sidewalk, driveways, curb and gutter repair, and ADA ramp upgrades.
 - a. New driveways need to be shown on the approved site plan.
 - b. The City has a pavement cut policy which affects concrete work in rights-of-way. Show repair limits on the plans.
- 4. If a project has a large number or complex off-site improvements, it may be better to submit on-site and off-site plans concurrently through a traditional review process.
 - a. For example: long lead items such as a USA Fee Title land swap or abandonment.
