Temporary Fencing

The temporary outdoor dining program does not require the use of fences to identify newly created outdoor dining areas. If a business wants to include temporary (not secured/anchored to the ground) fencing, a separate building permit will most likely not be required so long as adequate ingress/egress space is made available. Some examples of temporary fencing include:



Businesses who wish to include the sale and consumption of alcoholic beverages in their newly created temporary outdoor dining space, should confirm fencing requirements with the Arizona Liquor License and Control Department: <u>azliquor.gov</u>.

Fencing that is secured/anchored to the groud does require a building permit from the City of Phoenix Planning and Development Department.
