With the exception of the site plan, documents are preferred to be 8 1/2" x 11". Larger documents will be accepted, provided they fold flat. A. □ P6.1.3	Sign should use materials or textures which are complimentary to those used in the building or project being signed.
□ P6.1.4	Signs should use colors which match or compliment the colors used on the building or project being signed.
□ P 6.2.1	Sign locations should be integrated within the design of the site and the adjacent streetscape.
□ P6.2.2	Signs should be placed so they are not obscured by landscaping when it has reached full maturity.
□ P6.3.1	Sign placement and materials for multiple tenant occupancies should be delineated in a uniform and consistent manner.

Character

The following Design Review Considerations are concepts that should be considered in developing a project:

- 6.1.2 Signs should conform to the character of the context area as it is more specifically defined in any adopted plan for the area.
- 6.2.3 Consideration should be given to the location and design of signs on adjacent parcels.
