

Adaptive Reuse Evaluation Report Policy

A permit may be issued for adaptive reuse projects utilizing an Evaluation Report sealed by a registrant. This method focuses on using an evaluation report in lieu of a full plan submittal. This is targeted toward projects with very little new construction work. While a full set of asbuilt plans will not be required, plans may be needed for any new construction.

A separate procedure which details this process can be found in the TRT documents called "Issuing Permit Using Evaluation Report".

This policy applies to Tiers 1, 2, and 3 for structures permitted prior to 2000.

- <u>Tier 1</u>: 5,000 sq. ft. maximum. This can include an addition to the existing building. The addition cannot exceed 50% of the square footage of the existing building and a combined total of 5,000 square feet.
- Tier 2: Greater than 5,000 sq. ft. to 25,000 sq. ft.
- <u>Tier 3</u>: Greater than 25,000 sq. ft. to 100,000 sq. ft. and Large Scale Commercial Retail as defined in the Zoning Ordinance "big box" (Mercantile Occupancy).
