ZONING

The following activities require an *Administrative Temporary Use Permit* (ATUP) submitted in person at the Zoning Counter in the City of Phoenix Planning and Development Department or through the SHAPE PHX Customer Portal at https://shapephx.phoenix.gov/s/:

- Construction staging / lay down yards
- Interim surface parking lots (If within the downtown area a Use Permit is required).
- Employment (hiring) office during construction
- Temporary generators

RIGHT OF WAY

The Right-of-Way Management Section within the Street Transportation Department is responsible for the review and approval of traffic control specifications. The following activities require a *Temporary Restriction and Closure System* (TRACS) permit:

- Roadway, alley or sidewalk closure
- Traffic lane restrictions
- Sidewalk restrictions
- Parking meter hooding

To request a TRACS permit application and permit, coordinate with your Civil Inspector or contact the Right-of-Way Management section at (602) 262-6235.

EXTENDED CONSTRUCTION WORK HOURS

City Code 23-14 (h) restricts construction to non-holiday weekdays between the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM October 1st through April 30th and 6:00 AM to 7:00 PM May 1st through September 30th. Permits for extended work hours may be issued for emergency conditions or if the public peace and quiet will not be unreasonably disturbed. SAFEGUARDS DURING CONSTRUCTION

Adjoining public and private property shall be protected from damage during construction. Excavations, overhead work and water runoff shall all be considered in the *Construction Logistics Plan*.

Protection of pedestrians must comply with 2012 IBC Sec 3306 and Table 3306.1, which may include the use of covered walkways. The following link outlines the policy to obtain the appropriate pedestrian protection permit.
