The Cross Retention and Drainage Agreement is utilized when adjacent properties desire, or are required to, provide a perpetual, non-exclusive, mutual cross retention and drainage easement for the purposes of storm water retention and drainage. This agreement shall include notarized signatures from the property owner(s) of each associated parcel, signed by designated city of Phoenix personnel, and recorded with the County Recorder of Maricopa County, Arizona. This agreement must be approved and recorded prior to Final Plat approval or Grading and Drainage plan approval if no plat is required for the project.
