## NOVEMBER 4, 2014 SPECIAL ELECTION NOTICE OF ELECTION

On Tuesday, Nov. 4, 2014, registered voters residing in the city of Phoenix will vote on an initiative proposing an amendment to the City Charter related to the city's employee retirement system. This city ballot measure will appear on the ballot for the Nov. 4, General Election being conducted by Maricopa County.

### Important Dates

- Earliest date to request a ballot by mail .....Aug. 4, 2014 (Monday)
- Latest date to file ballot measure arguments .....Aug. 6, 2014 (Wednesday)
- Mail Publicity Pamphlet with sample of the ballot.....Sept. 29, 2014 (Monday)
- Latest date to register to vote .....Oct. 6, 2014 (Monday)
- Early voting and mailing of early ballots begins.....Oct. 9, 2014 (Thursday)
- Latest date to request a ballot by mail .....Oct. 24, 2014 (Friday)
- Last day to vote at early voting sites .....Oct. 31, 2014 (Friday)
- ELECTION DAY .....Nov. 4, 2014 (Tuesday)

### Early Voting

City voters on the Permanent Early Voting List (PEVL) will automatically receive an early ballot by mail unless they submitted a request to not receive a ballot by mail. Voters who are not on the PEVL can request an early ballot from Maricopa County no later than Friday, Oct. 24, by calling 602-506-1511 or online at [recorder.maricopa.gov/EVRequest](http://recorder.maricopa.gov/EVRequest). Early ballots will be mailed beginning Thursday, Oct. 9. In-person early voting also will be available from Thursday, Oct. 9 through Friday, Oct. 31, during normal business hours at Maricopa County Elections offices and on the 15th floor of Phoenix City Hall.

### Voting at the Polls

Because Maricopa County will conduct the election, traditional polling places will be used, with one polling place designated for each county voting precinct. Voters must vote at the one specific polling location designated for the precinct where they reside. These polling places will be open on Election Day (Tuesday, Nov. 4) from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. Voting centers will not be used for this election. A polling place locator for the Special Election will be available about 60 days before the Election on the county's website at [recorder.maricopa.gov/web/elections.aspx](http://recorder.maricopa.gov/web/elections.aspx) or by calling 602-506-1511. Additionally, the name and address of the polling place for each voter household will be identified on the Sample Ballot (provided by Maricopa County) and the Publicity Pamphlet (provided by the City) that will be mailed to each voter household prior to the Election.
