#### **NEW PENSION SYSTEM**

The City of Phoenix Employees' Retirement System (COPERS) is implementing a new pension administration system which will allow us to better support our members.


During January and February of 2024, our

Benefits Staff will be completing every process in both our current system and the new system to verify that everything is processing perfectly before going live in the new system on Mar. 1. We ask for your patience during this time. Appointments with our office will be limited to employees who are eligible to retire before July 1, 2024. If you are not eligible until after July 1, 2024, please reach out to us after Mar. 1.

We also ask for your patience regarding the timing of annual member statements. They will be processed from the new system and should be going out sometime in February of 2024. Thank you and we wish everyone a very Happy New Year!

#### **VACATION CARRYOVER**

The City has updated **A.R. 2.18**, reinstating the standard vacation carryover tables to reflect the current



vacation amounts eligible for carryover each year. View the <u>carryover tables</u> for vacation amounts eligible for carryover into 2024. (You will be required to login using your City credentials.)

Please note the following:

- There is a separate table for employees in Units
   3, 4, and 6
- There are no changes to the monthly accrual rate or the maximum accrual compensated at separation

Employees are encouraged to take their vacation whenever possible. Taking vacation leave is an important benefit for health, productivity, personal development, and life enjoyment. Please review the revised **A.R. 2.18** as soon as possible to determine the best options for excess vacation time. Contact your HR liaison with any questions.
