

In the aftermath of Stonewall, a newly politicized Vito Russo found his voice as a gay activist and critic of LGBT representation in the media. Aviation Dispatcher — \$20.55-30.13/hour

The Aviation Department is seeking motivated and dedicated Aviation Dispatchers to join their team. Aviation Dispatchers in the Airport Command Center are responsible for receiving and dispatching emergency and non-emergency calls to police, fire, operations, and maintenance airport personnel.

The Aviation Department is a 24/7 operation. Employees are required to work evenings, nights, weekends, and holidays. Vacation and shift assignments are determined by seniority which will require working second or third shift for an indefinite amount of time.

This job requires one year of experience in the operation of two-way radio and/or telephone switchboard equipment, including some experience in general typing and clerical work and the ability to type at least 35 words per minute. Recruitment closes June 22.

Dispatcher positions are a hot career at the City. Be sure to spread the work to people with the ability to remain calm under pressure, multitask, and listen carefully and identify key information from callers.

DID YOU KNOW?

Under the “how to apply” section of every job recruitment, candidates are given the instruction to attach “your cover letter and resume as one document.” Please be sure you are uploading one attachment with both documents when applying for jobs - don't skip out on writing a cover letter! This is a great vehicle to introduce yourself and to draw attention to specific job experience related to the job you're applying for. Many hiring managers read your cover letter to assess your writing ability and style, and also to ensure that you have properly followed the instructions for the application.
