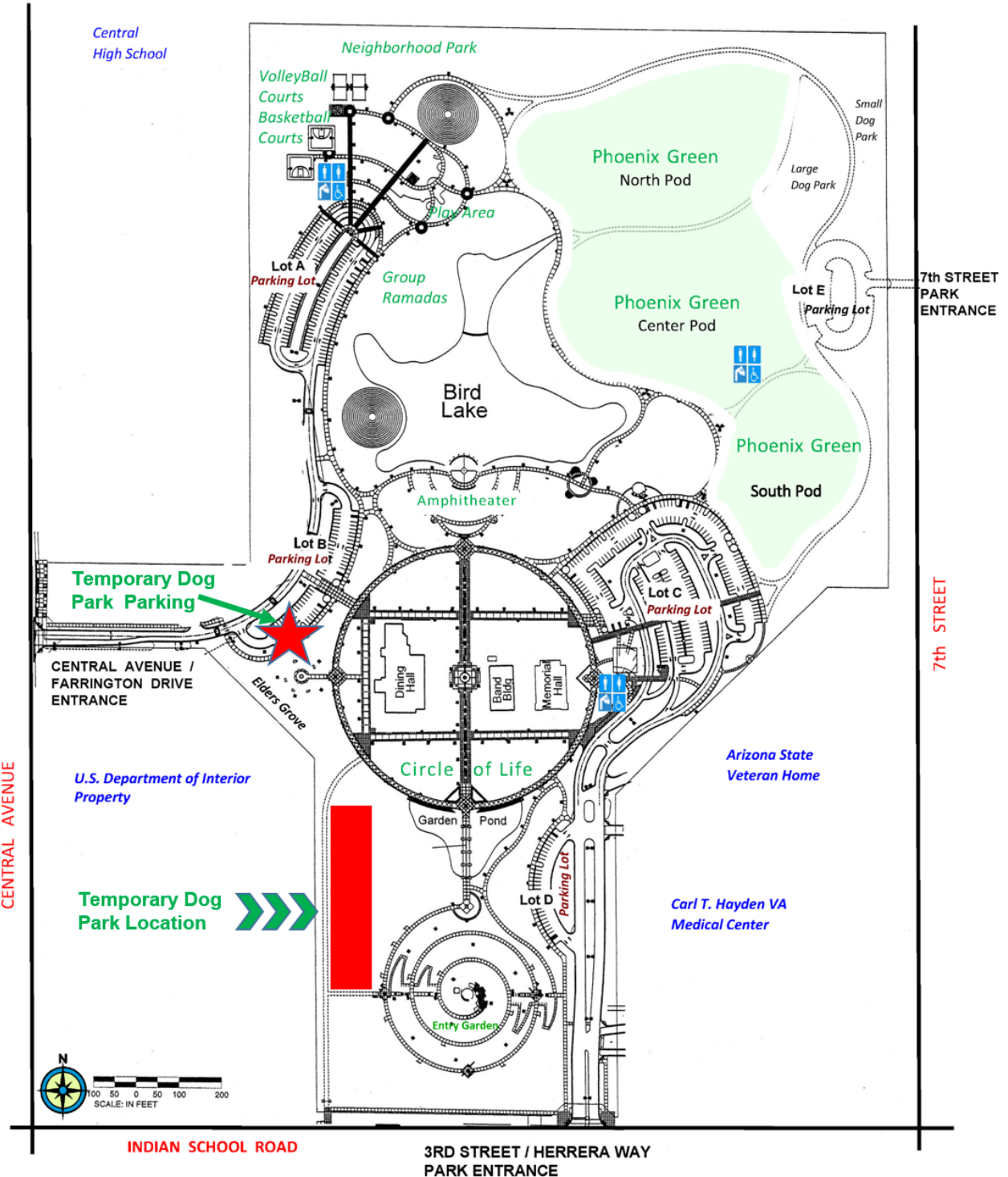


STEELE INDIAN SCHOOL PARK RESTRICTIONS/CLOSURES



Steele Indian School Park

300 E. Indian School Rd. • Phoenix, AZ 85012



Starting Wednesday October 11 – Sunday October 15, limited public access to park amenities:

- **Dog Park**
 - Permanent Dog Park will be closed Tuesday October 10 at 10pm and reopen on Thursday, October 25 at 6am.
 - Temporary Dog Park will be open Wednesday October 11 at 6am. It is located in southwest area of the Park - Circle of Life Park (near the Entry Garden). The Temporary parking is in Lot B Parking Lot – access from Farrington Drive Park Entrance.
- **Bird Lake Fishing**
 - Access to the lake will be available to the public.
- **Phoenix Green**
 - These areas will be restricted and unavailable to public.
- **Phoenix Indian School Visitors Center Building** (*former Band Building*)
 - The visitor center will be open and available to the public.
- **Parking Lots**
 - South end of park – parking lot (**Lot D**) will be available to public.
 - West end of park - parking lots (**Lot A & B**) will be available to public.
 - East end of park - parking lot (**Lot C**) will be restricted and unavailable to public.
- **Neighborhood Park – Ramadas/Playground/Basketball & Volleyball Courts**
 - These areas will be available to public.
- **Exercise Trail**
 - East trail route near Phoenix Greens will be restricted.
 - Remaining trail routes will be available to public.
- **Park Entrances**
 - South end – 3rd Street/Herrera Way will be available to public.
 - West end - Central Avenue/Farrington Way will be available to public.
 - East end - 7th Street will be restricted and unavailable to public.

Starting Monday October 16 – Wednesday October 25, the entire park will be closed to the public and will reopen on Thursday October 26, except the Temporary Dog Park – see schedule below.

Temporary Dog Park Schedule / Hours:

- Oct. 11 – Oct. 19: Open / 6 am to 10 pm
- Oct. 20 – Oct. 22: Closed during Festival Event Days
- Oct. 23 – Oct. 25: Open / 6 am to 10 pm
