- UNID. PERSON: Black female, middle aged, 5'03", 100 pounds, with very short hair (possibly white on top). She had evidence of past surgery on her fallopian tubes and had a tubal ligation (with plastic rings). She was missing all of her upper teeth and many of her lower teeth.
- CLOTHING: Blue pants and a gray shirt, wearing two gold-colored necklaces and a watch on her left wrist.
- DATE FOUND: February 4, 1997 at 7:00 P.M.
- NARRATIVE: On February 4, 1997 at 7:00 P.M. this female was found inside a burning vehicle (blue two door Honda) in the area of North 24th Street and East Monroe Street in Phoenix, Arizona. Found near the vehicle was a brown vinyl purse with handwriting on it that mentioned the name "Monique." It is unknown if this purse belonged to the victim. Witnesses said the female had been seen in the local area before and was possibly a transient with mental issues.
