CLOTHING: Blue tank top which read "Colorado University Boulder," white sweatshirt with 1988 Olympic logos, white tennis shoes with black laces, and black pants. Found in the pockets of the pants was a matchbook and papers associated with "Barley's Restaurant."

DATE FOUND: June 8, 1990.

NARRATIVE: On June 8, 1990 this male was found in a holding tank at a water treatment plant in the area of South 22nd Street and Lincoln Street in Phoenix, Arizona. Due to chemicals used in the flushing of the tank, the body was greatly deteriorated. The image above is a clay reconstruction of what the victim may have looked like.
