He also had a scar on his right knee.
- CLOTHING: White t-shirt with the words "Pulmcroft Family Fellowship Camp" on it, khaki pants, and black sneakers.

DATE FOUND: August 4, 1997.

NARRATIVE: On August 4, 1997 this male was found deceased in a field in the area of Central Avenue and Buckeye Road. He had papers in the name of "Juan Martinez" (4/13/70) but this could not be verified and is likely not his name. He died of a drug overdose but his true identity has never been determined.
