Late Night Shooting and Collision Ends in Arrest

(November 18, 2023) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a late-night shooting and related collision that left a several hospitalized to include the suspect.

On November 17, 2023, around 9:10 p.m., Phoenix police officers responded to the area of 36th Street and McDowell Road regarding a shooting at a local business. When officers arrived, they located in total four adult males with injuries suffered as a result of the shooting. Three of the men suffered gunshot wounds and were all transported to local hospitals with what are now considered non-life-threatening injuries. The fourth man was injured by debris from the shooting and was treated on scene by Phoenix Fire.

It was learned that an adult male suspect entered the business and began firing a handgun causing the listed injuries. The suspect fled the area in a vehicle and was followed from the scene by a witness. The suspect traveled to the area of 44th Street and Campbell Road when he ran a red light causing a collision with two other vehicles. The suspect vehicle rolled over causing the man to be injured. He was transported to a local hospital for what is now determined to be non-life-threatening injuries. The drivers of the other two vehicles involved in the collision were also transported to local hospitals, both with non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to assume the two related investigations. Evidence located at the scene of the collision links the suspect to the shooting. The man remains in the hospital receiving treatment.

When he is released from medical care, he will be booked on several felony charges. At this time the man's information will not be released. Once he is officially booked, his information can and will be disseminated. All other aspects of this case remain part of the ongoing investigation.
