Medical Event Leads to Fatal Collision

(November 10, 2023) Detectives investigate a single vehicle collision inside the Phoenix South Mountain Park that led to the death of a man and the hospitalizations of three passengers.

Phoenix Police responded to the intersection of Central Avenue and Las Ramadas Drive located inside the Phoenix South Mountain Park and Preserve on November 9, 2023, at about 3:00 p.m. to investigate a serious collision. When officers got to the scene, they found a man, identified as 65-year-old Randy Stover, who was pronounced deceased by Phoenix Fire personnel. Stover was identified as the driver of the SUV, with three passengers, two adult males and one teenaged male. All three passengers were taken to the hospital with serious but non-life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to the scene and learned Stover experienced a medical emergency while driving north on Central Avenue and lost control of the vehicle. The SUV went off the road crashing into the desert area. Additional details related to the incident remain part of the ongoing investigation.
