Extensive work completed by detectives led to the arrest of three juvenile males on June 23, 2023. All suspects were booked into Juvenile Courts Center in connection to the drive-by shooting death of 46-year-old Mark Resendez.

Homicide Investigation

(April 10, 2023) A man has died after a drive-by shooting near 29th Avenue and Madison Street.

On April 10, 2023 just after midnight, Phoenix Police responded to a call of shots fired near 29th Avenue and Madison Street. Officers found a man, later identified as 46-year-old Mark Resendez, suffering from gunshot wounds in the driveway of his residence. Resendez was transported to the hospital where he died.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Early information indicates Resendez was in front of his residence when an unknown vehicle drove by and began shooting at him. The suspect(s) remain outstanding. Details about what led up to the shooting are still under investigation. This remains an ongoing investigation.
