During the interview, the man provided self-defense statements that were consistent with witness on scene. The man was released from custody and charges will be submitted for review by the Maricopa County Attorney's Office.

Suspect Sought in Deadly Stabbing

(May 3, 2023) Phoenix homicide detectives are investigating a deadly stabbing that happened in the area of 48th Street and Washington Street Wednesday morning.

On May 3, 2023, at about 10:19 a.m., Phoenix officers were called to the area of 500 South 48th Street for a stabbing call. When officers got to the scene, they found an adult man suffering from a stab wound. Fire personnel got to the scene and pronounced the man deceased.

Officers immediately began searching the area using K-9's and the Air Unit, however, no suspects were located.

Detectives with the Phoenix Police Homicide Unit took over the investigation and learned that the victim and the suspect engaged in a fight with edged weapons before the victim was fatally stabbed. The suspect left the area prior to police arriving and is believed to have suffered sharp force injuries himself.

Details of this case are still being investigated by detectives. If anyone has information that can lead to an arrest in this case, they are asked to call into Silent Witness at 480-WITNESS or 480-TESTIGO and may be eligible for a cash reward.
