UPDATE: October 15, 2024

Since the homicide investigation began, detectives have collected multiple elements of evidence to include surveillance footage, that led to the identification of a possible suspect, 47-year-old Jason Fleming. Probable cause was established to arrest Fleming for the murder. A search for Fleming was unsuccessful in locating him.

On October 15, 2024, Phoenix police responded to the area 18th Avenue and Union Hills Drive regarding a trespassing. During this call for service, Fleming was contacted and ultimately arrested. After a brief interview, Fleming was booked into jail on murder, along with additional charges unrelated to the homicide investigation.

North Phoenix Stabbing Leaves One Man Dead

(September 15, 2024): Detectives are looking for a suspect that stabbed a man to death near a gas station property.

Officers were called to a stabbing near a gas station at 28th Avenue and Thunderbird Road. When officers arrived, they found a man suffering from a stab wound. The fire department responded and transported the man to the hospital, where he later died from his injuries. Officers searched for witnesses and surveillance of the incident.

Detectives were called to take over the investigation. Currently, no suspects have been detained. Anyone with information is asked to contact Phoenix police or Silent Witness if they wish to remain anonymous.
