Woman Shot and Killed in South Phoenix

(May 30, 2024): A man is facing manslaughter charges for shooting and killing a woman outside her home.

Just after 1:30 a.m., officers were called to a shooting near 14th Street and Wier Avenue. When officers arrived, they found a woman suffering from a gunshot wound just outside a mobile home. Officers provided aid to the woman until the fire department arrived. The woman, later identified as 38-year-old Genoveva Antillon, was rushed to the hospital where she later died from her injuries. Officers were able to speak to multiple people on the property who stated they only heard the gunshots.

Homicide detectives responded to take over the case. During their investigation, detectives spoke to the witnesses and processed the crime scene. While conducting their interviews, detectives spoke to 35-year-old Maury Williamson who provided statements that were inconsistent with the crime scene. He was questioned on those inconsistencies and later admitted to shooting Antillon accidentally when he shot at a dog on the property that he thought was attacking him. The firearm was found hidden inside the mobile home and recovered by detectives after a search warrant was obtained.

Williamson was booked on multiple felonies to include Manslaughter, Weapons Violations, and Tampering with Evidence. The investigation remains active.
