UPDATE: May 7, 2024

On May 6, 2024, suspect Eduardo Ramirez-Galindo turned himself in to Customs and Border Patrol agents at the Lukeville, Arizona station. He was then taken into custody by Phoenix police detectives and returned to Phoenix. He was interviewed by detectives and made admissions regarding the death of victim Casarrubias Romero. Ramirez-Galindo was booked into the Maricopa County Jail on one count of Second-Degree Murder.

Woman Found Stabbed to Death Inside Home

(May 5, 2024): A woman was found dead inside her home after a late-night altercation.

Just before 8:30 am, officers received a check welfare call at a home near 27th Avenue and Devonshire Avenue. Officers arrived and spoke to the caller, who stated he found blood on his driveway that led into his tenant's portion of the house. Officers entered the home and found 24-year-old Andrea Casarrubias Romero deceased from what appeared to be multiple stab wounds.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation by interviewing witnesses, collecting evidence, and processing the scene. Preliminary information suggests Casarrubias Romero was assaulted, sometime overnight, by a known suspect who is currently outstanding. Detectives are currently following leads as they work to locate the suspect. The investigation remains active.
