## **Road Rage Incident Ends in Shooting**

(November 14, 2024): Phoenix detectives investigate road rage incident that leaves one man dead.

On November 13, 2024, around 6:30 p.m., officers responded to a shooting in the area of 2700 West Dunlap Avenue. As they arrived, officers located the victim, who was identified as 22-year-old Aramis Ross, suffering from a gunshot wound. The Phoenix Fire Department transported him to a nearby hospital where he was diagnosed with a non-survivable, catastrophic brain injury.

Homicide investigators responded, processed the scene, and conducted interviews. Preliminary information learned at the scene suggest that the victim and the suspect were involved in an extended road rage incident. After stopping in traffic near 2700 West Dunlap Avenue, the incident concluded with the suspect firing a gun and striking the victim. The suspect was detained a short time later after he notified police of his involvement.

The investigation is ongoing. Additional details related to this incident remain part of the investigation. Once the investigation is complete it will be submitted to the Maricopa County Attorney's Office for review.
