Pedestrian Dead After Early Morning Collision

(December 30, 2024) Detectives are investigating a collision that left a pedestrian dead early Monday morning.

On December 30, 2024, just before 5:00 a.m., officers responded to the area of 32nd Street and Bell Road, just south, regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located a scene where an adult female pedestrian had been struck by a vehicle. The fire department had rushed the woman to the hospital where she died.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the woman was crossing from the west side of the 32nd Street, midblock, and was struck by a vehicle traveling southbound on 32nd Street.

The driver involved was not injured, remained on scene and was evaluated. Impairment is not believed to be a factor in this collision.

Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
