Bicyclist Dead After a Hit and Run Collision

(August 17, 2024): Phoenix police is investigating a fatal hit and run collision that left a man dead and a suspect outstanding.

Officers were called to a vehicle collision just after 1:45 a.m. near 40th Street and Oak Street. When officers arrived, they found a man suffering from obvious signs of trauma while lying on the sidewalk. The fire department responded and transported the man, later identified as 46-year-old David Pinkerton, to the hospital where he later died from his injuries.

Detectives responded to investigate the collision and speak to witnesses. Preliminary information suggests Pinkerton was heading southbound on 40th Street on the west side of the street when he was hit by a vehicle also heading southbound on 40th Street. The vehicle left the area, after the collision, towards an unknown direction. The vehicle and suspect remain outstanding.
