UPDATE: June 25, 2024

Over the last three months, Phoenix Police Homicide Unit along with the Tactical Support Bureau's Street Crimes Unit worked relentlessly to locate and arrest Xavier Hughley for this homicide. On June 25, 2024, Street Crimes investigators located Xavier in the area of 31st Avenue and West Campbell Avenue, where the Special Assignments Unit took him into custody without incident. Xavier was booked for first-degree murder and misconduct involving weapons.

UPDATE: April 11, 2024

On April 9, 2024, 43-year-old victim, Amanda George passed away from injuries sustained in a late March shooting that left her hospitalized. The known suspect, Xavier Hughley, is still outstanding and wanted for the violent murder of Amanda George.

Detectives Seek Help in Finding Suspect

(April 1, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are searching for a lead suspect in the tragic shooting of an adult female victim that happened almost a week ago in west Phoenix.

On March 27, 2024, at about 9:25 p.m., Phoenix police officers responded to a shooting near 3400 North 67th Lane. Officers on scene found the adult female victim inside the residence with an apparent gunshot wound. Phoenix Fire responded and provided lifesaving treatment as the victim was taken to the hospital. The victim was hospitalized with serious life-threatening injuries.

Detectives responded to the scene and took over the investigation. It has since been learned that 30-year-old Xavier Hughley was involved in this violent incident and is being sought by detectives. The

community is asked to provide any information into Hughley's whereabouts by calling into Silent Witness at 480-WITNESS or 480-TESTIGO.
