Overnight Collision Leaves Man Dead

(February 3, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a collision in a north valley parking lot that left one man dead.

On February 3, 2024, around 12:45 a.m., officers responded to the area of 29th Street and Bell Road regarding a collision where a vehicle struck the wall of a nearby apartment complex. When officers arrived, they located the vehicle involved and the adult male driver, identified as 32-year-old Kelvin Perez. Perez did not have any visible injuries but was pronounced deceased on scene by the fire department.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. The Office of the Medical Examiner responded to collect the remains. They will determine the cause of death. It appears that the vehicle driven by Perez struck a wall as he was inside of an apartment complex. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
