North Valley Collision Leaves One Dead Another Hospitalized

(May 29, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a collision that left a woman dead and a man in the hospital.

On May 29, 2024, around 12:55 p.m., officers responded to the area of Jomax Road and Tatum Boulevard regarding a collision that resulted in injuries. When officers arrived, an adult male and female were found to be injured. The man was transported to a nearby hospital and remains there in stable condition. The woman, identified as 87-year-old Shirley June Goodspeed, was also transported to a nearby hospital. She unfortunately did not survive her injuries and was pronounced deceased. Both vehicles involved remained on scene after the collision.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the vehicle that contained Goodspeed as a passenger was northbound on Tatum Boulevard and making a left turn onto Jomax Road. This vehicle struck the other vehicle involved, which was southbound on Tatum Boulevard. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation. Charging decisions will be made after the accident reconstruction process is complete.
