Midday Collision Leaves Motorcycle Rider Dead

(September 21, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a collision that left a motorcycle rider dead.

On September 21, 2024, around 2:30 p.m., officers responded to the area of 32nd Street and Thomas Road regarding a collision involving a motorcycle. When officers arrived, they located the adult female motorcycle rider, identified as 28-year-old Janae Levine, with serious injuries. Levine was transported to a nearby hospital where she unfortunately did not survive her injuries and was pronounced deceased. The vehicle involved in the collision remained on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the vehicle involved was westbound on Thomas Road and making a left turn when it struck Levine on her motorcycle as she was traveling eastbound on Thomas Road. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation. Charging decisions will be made once the accident reconstruction process is complete.
