Early Morning Collision Leaves Pedestrian Dead

(September 20, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating an east valley collision that resulted in man's death.

On September 20, 2024, around 5:00 a.m., officers responded to the area of 43rd Street and Van Buren Street regarding a collision involving a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located an adult male, identified as 35-year-old Foster Williams, with serious injuries. Williams did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene. The two vehicles involved in the collision remained on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that Williams was in the westbound lanes of Van Buren Street when he was struck by two the vehicles involved. Charging decisions will be made once the accident reconstruction process is complete. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
