Detectives Searching for Vehicle After Fatal Hit and Run Collision

(September 21, 2024) Phoenix Police detectives are investigating a hit and run collision that left a man dead.

On September 20, 2024, around 8:40 p.m., officers responded to the area of 27th Avenue and Bethany Home Road regarding a collision that involved a pedestrian. When officers arrived, they located the adult male pedestrian, identified as 37-year-old Matthew Argentino, with serious injuries. Argentino did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene. The vehicle involved took off from the scene prior to police arrival.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that the vehicle involved was northbound on 27th Avenue when it struck Argentino who was crossing 27th Avenue midblock. The vehicle continued north on 27th Avenue leaving the scene. The vehicle is described as a grey 4-door sedan. Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation. Anyone with information is asked to call Silent Witness at 480(WITNESS) or 480(TESTIGO) and provide an anonymous tip. Rewards will be paid for information leading to an arrest in this case.
