Midday Collision Leaves Motorcycle Rider Dead

(August 13, 2024) Phoenix Police Vehicular Crimes detectives identify the victim of a collision that left one man dead.

On August 13, 2024, around 1:14 p.m., officers responded to a collision involving a motorcyclist in the area of North 9th Street and East Bell Road. Officers located an adult male motorcyclist suffering from critical injuries. Unfortunately, 60-year-old Parris Frazier did not survive his injuries and was pronounced deceased on scene.

Detectives responded to take over the investigation. Preliminary information suggests that Unit 1 the Nissan Altima that was operated by an adult male, was traveling eastbound on Bell Road when the operator failed to yield turning left (north) onto 9th Street and was struck by Unit 2, a Harley Davidson Sportster that was operated by 60-year-old Parris Frazier. The operator of the Nissan was not injured and remained on scene. The operator of the Harley sustained fatal injuries and was pronounced on scene.

Additional details about the collision remain part of the ongoing investigation.
